I plan to change the AP for next year using the St. Catherine against our Mocks as it is, but we need to lower the benchmarks for the St. Catherine but not the twelve weeks. I believe this is an excellent exercise in helping our students acclimate to questions that are not presented the way their teachers are. The change will be to assess their mock final scores against their actual test scores as a separate analysis rather than in the same breakout. Too confusing.
