Advancing Care Through Innovation



World-first achievement

In 2025, the Henry Ford Macomb team, led by cardiothoracic surgeon Raed Alnajjar, MD, became the first in the world to use the MONARCH robotic bronchoscopy platform with MONARCH QUEST—an AI-powered navigation system designed to improve precision targeting of lung nodules and support earlier, more accurate diagnosis.



State first in robotic lung cancer surgery

The Henry Ford Macomb heart and vascular team performed the first single-port robotic lung cancer resection in the state of Michigan. This advanced approach uses a single small incision, offering patients less pain, faster recovery, and reduced scarring compared to traditional thoracic surgery.



World-class rehabilitation partnership

Through our partnership with Shirley Ryan AbilityLab, patients at Henry Ford Macomb Hospital have access to nationally recognized inpatient rehabilitation—bringing leading recovery and rehabilitation care closer to home.



Thrombectomy-Capable Stroke Center

In 2024, Henry Ford Macomb Hospital earned designation as a Thrombectomy-Capable Stroke Center, strengthening our ability to treat complex strokes with advanced, minimally invasive intervention. This certification allows more patients to receive specialized stroke care close to home.

Metro Detroit Heart & Stroke Walk

More than 125 team members from Henry Ford Macomb Hospital participated in the Metro Detroit Heart & Stroke Walk—raising awareness for heart and stroke health while demonstrating our commitment to prevention and community well-being.



Wellness Wednesdays at The Mall at Partridge Creek

Henry Ford Macomb Hospital hosted 14 weeks of free Wellness Wednesday exercise classes, bringing accessible, community-based fitness and wellness programming to a popular local gathering place.



Healthy Heart Screening Event

Henry Ford Macomb Hospital was one of six sites across the system to host a Healthy Heart Screening event, offering free heart screenings—including EKGs—with same-day results and one-on-one conversations with a physician to help participants understand their heart health and risk factors.
