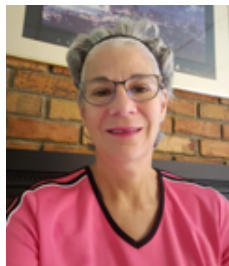

#### **All of Us is ready to welcome you back!**

Henry Ford has resumed in-person activities at our Henry Ford Hospital location and we're starting by rescheduling appointments that we had to cancel last spring. Additional clinics will be opening in the near future.

Here are some of the changes you will see when you next visit us:

- Screening all patients, visitors and staff before entry to our facilities including a temperature check. Those who show possible signs of illness are referred for proper medical care.
- Masks being worn at all times by staff, patients and visitors. Those who need a mask will receive one upon entry.
- Staff wearing appropriate personal protective equipment when providing care and adhering to strict handwashing protocols.
- Enacting social distancing measures for spaces like elevators, waiting areas, lobbies, cafeterias and more.
- Enhancing cleaning practices with even more frequent disinfecting of common areas like waiting rooms and lobbies.

### Henry Ford Vaccination Update

Henry Ford has been working hard on the vaccination process. Vaccine supplies remain limited, but we're working with our local and state agency partners to boost our supply as much as possible and increase the number of appointments we can offer our patients and our community. The type of vaccine offered to Henry Ford patients is based on the supply available. **We are offering vaccines by appointment only.**

If you are an established Henry Ford patient, we will contact you by text, email or phone when you become eligible to receive a vaccine and as appointments become available. We will reach out to you based on the contact information you have provided to us to let you know when you can schedule a vaccine appointment.

- When it's your turn to get the vaccine, and you receive your notification, you can schedule your appointment in [MyChart](#). Here are [instructions on how to schedule your appointment](#) through MyChart.

Henry Ford has given more than 221,000 total doses of the COVID-19 vaccine. We now have vaccine supply commitments that will allow us to administer up to 25,000 shots per week starting this week. In addition, our clinical and administrative support of the federal vaccination site at Ford Field is outstanding and helping our state to be in the top 10 of all states in vaccination rates as a percentage of its eligible population.
