Abstract submission will be open **April 1, 2026 – June 1, 2026** The Eye, The Brain and the Auto planning committee seeks high quality abstracts that present recent, original work **from the last two years**. We encourage new, unpublished findings as part of your presentation.

### **Key Dates for the 2026 Abstract Program:**

**June 1, 2026 Abstract submission deadline**

**June 15, 2026 Abstract notification of acceptance**

- The abstract must be approved by all co-authors.
- A Platform Presentation must be submitted with the intention that, if accepted, it will be presented in person, in a 20-minute talk, followed by a 10-minute challenge period.
- All financial relationships with commercial interests relevant to the research reported in the abstract must be disclosed.
- Registration for the Congress is not required to submit an abstract.
- If a submitted abstract is accepted for Platform Presentation, the First Author or presenter will be eligible for up to two nights' complimentary lodging and complimentary congress registration fee.
- Accepted presenters with financial hardship may apply for a travel scholarship. Please send a brief description of your circumstances and your biography by July 15, 2026.
- If an abstract is not accepted for Platform Presentation, the organizers may invite the authors to present the material as a Poster.
- There is no limit on the number of abstracts that can be submitted by an individual, or a research or clinical group.
- There is a maximum of 2,500 total characters; excluding the abstract's title but including characters and spaces in the abstract body and image captions; maximum of two images
- Font/Size: Times New Roman/12 pt., Portrait Orientation
- Please send a short Biography (maximum 1,500 characters including spaces) and headshot of yourself (JPEG, GIF file) to rhorne1@hfhs.org for publication purposes by July 15, 2026.
- If you will need to apply for a Visa and need an invitation letter, contact Roseanne Horne at Rhorne1@hfhs.org
- **Abstract headings strongly preferred are Purpose, Method, Results, and Conclusion**
